VOLUNTEER ASSIGNMENTS

Internships are available in the following departments: Animal Care, Camp Counselors and Therapeutic Programs. Specific responsibilities and qualifications vary by department. For more information, please check the description for the position that you are applying for.

HOUSING

Heartland Farm Sanctuary does not provide housing for interns at this time. We do have a list of housing options and contacts that can be email upon request.

MEALS

Interns are responsible for buying and preparing their own food. Out of respect for the animals and work that Heartland Farm Sanctuary does, all staff and interns are required to adhere to a vegetarian or vegan diet while on sanctuary premises.

SCHEDULES

Interns have the option to volunteer full-time (40 hours per week), 30 hours per week, or 20 hours per week. Scheduling varies by department.

AVAILABILITY

Most Heartland Farm Sanctuary internships are available year round. Positions are filled on an ongoing basis as applications are received. Summer positions fill quickly, so, if you're interested in these months, be sure to contact us well in advance.
