**How You Will Make a Difference:**

Therapists at Heartland play a critical role in addressing the individual needs of participants and inspiring compassion for all people and animals. You will engage in the therapeutic process with participants, including intake, assessment, planning, implementation, and evaluation. You will uphold the values of Heartland Farm Sanctuary to foster the human-animal bond and facilitate growth toward individuals' goals.

The **Experiential Therapist** will be responsible for:

- Providing an array of Experiential Therapy services to promote individualized participant wellness and recovery.
- Providing participant-centered and family-centered care in all aspects of the development and implementation of treatment plans.
- Supporting intakes for individual and group therapy programs.
- Developing service plans and conducting reviews as needed.
- Providing Experiential Therapy assessments, referrals, and intervention services.
- Completing and maintaining documentation in a timely and accurate manner and according to federal, state, and organizational guidelines.
- Collaborating with community providers as well as representatives from county assistance programs to help schedule treatment sessions and secure funding for the participants who need it.
- Other duties as assigned.

**Who We Are Looking For:**

The Experiential Therapist must possess:

- A commitment to the mission and values of Heartland Farm Sanctuary.
- Current certification and or state licensure in a mental health or pediatric health related field.
- Ability to make professional evaluations, decisions, and recommendations for treatment planning and implementation.
- Previous experience in child and adolescent or behavioral health services.
- Excellent communication skills and ability to engage and inspire children and families.
- A willingness to work with farm animals and people of all ages.
- Ability to work independently while supporting a larger team effort.
- Reliable transportation to the sanctuary in Verona.
