- Maintaining a caseload of therapy participants
- Creating treatment plans and keeping timely session notes for each participant
- Using appropriate evidenced based techniques formulated and tailored to the participant's specified needs
- Communicating and collaborating extensively with Animal Care and Humane Education teams
- Coordinating care and collaborating on treatment goals with families, caregivers, and agency case managers
- Staying up to date with state laws and therapy compliance. Maintaining continuing education requirements
- Additional duties as assigned
