Heartland Farm Sanctuary's COVID-19 policies have been updated in alignment with Public Health Madison & Dane County.

Wearing masks

- **No face coverings/masks will be required at Heartland Farm Sanctuary.**
- **Important note:** At Heartland, we believe that people should feel 100% comfortable and supported if they choose to wear a mask while at the sanctuary. Staff, volunteers, tour guests, participant families and children are strongly encouraged to continue to act in alignment with their personal comfort level.

Physical distancing

- **No physical distancing will be required at Heartland Farm Sanctuary.**
- **Important note:** At Heartland, we believe that people should feel 100% comfortable and supported if they would like physical space. Staff, volunteers, tour guests, participant families and children are strongly encouraged to continue to act in alignment with their comfort level.

Handwashing

- **Indoors and outdoors:** Heartland staff **will continue to encourage regular hand-washing** and/or hand-sanitizing during programs, work shifts, and events. Hand sanitizer and hand-washing stations will be available.

Health screening

- Heartland **will continue to ask that all members of our community monitor for Covid-like symptoms and stay home if sick.**

For campers, guests and participants: If a program participant or guest tests positive for COVID-19 they should stay home until the following is met (based on the individual's health care provider):

- At least 24 hours have passed with no fever without fever-reducing medication AND symptoms have improved AND
- At least 5 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
- Taking another test after day 5 is encouraged. If the results continue to be positive, the participant should continue to isolate for another 5 days.
